

Where do my property taxes go?

Osage County residents, the pie chart above breaks down into percentage of how all tax dollars are being used in the county. The (87%) fund all Osage County Schools and Career Techs, only (11%) fund County General and (2%) fund Cities & Towns.

Cities which collect ad valorem tax, do so to fund sinking funds, which are used to pay for judgments and bond issues. The County portion of your property tax is used to fund all offices of the county, including maintenance of the Courthouse, the offices of the County Commissioners, County Clerks, Assessors, Treasurers, as well as the General Funding.

The Oklahoma State Statutes are very specific about how the county operates and how funds must be accounted for and expended. The majority of these laws can be found under Title 19 and 68
